



E-Bike Safety Reminders

E-Bikes

Class 1: Pedal Assist
& **Class 2:** Throttle Assist

- Max 20 MPH

Class 3: Pedal Assist

- Max 28 MPH
- 16+ years old to ride
- Helmet required (all ages)

It is against the law in California to modify or tamper with electric bikes without changing the bike's labeled classification.

E-Motorcycles

- **Full Motor Power:** Designed without pedaling.
- **Higher Speed:** Typically exceed 28 mph of Class 3 E-Bikes
- **Usage:** Approved motorized trails and Off Highway Vehicle recreation areas.
- **License required:** Not generally street legal. Operation on a roadway requires a valid motorcycle license, California DMV registration, and insurance.

Safety

- Wear a properly fastened helmet that is certified for the type of bike you are riding. All riders under 18 must wear a helmet.
- Sidewalks and crosswalks are meant for pedestrians.
- Traffic lights, stop signs, and road signs must be obeyed by all road users.
- Riding against the flow of traffic is prohibited.

Where to Ride

- Ride to the right edge of the road as practical, or middle when on a narrow road.
- Ride in the same direction as traffic and in bike lines.
- It is against the law to ride on sidewalks or crosswalks in a business district or on any street with a designated bike path.
